The RISE Storefront Improvement Program is designed to improve the functionality and physical appearance of commercial properties in the Five Points business district.

Financial and Technical Assistance

Eligible property owners and commercial tenants are assisted in renovating commercial building façades, enhancing exterior appearances, and removing architectural barriers to accessibility.

Storefront Improvement Program Grants


Grants are provided to fund well-designed improvements that will create attractive store fronts and functional commercial spaces. Financial assistance will be awarded in the form of reimbursable grants up to \$5,000, based on the proposed scope of work and availability of funds.

Eligible Improvement Projects

- signage improvements
- architectural detail restoration
- windows and doors
- accessibility barrier removal
- lighting improvements
- patio and surface lot upgrades
- exterior space upgrades
- and much more!
